# Message

Rock mechanics is an academic and technical field related to the construction of social infrastructure facilities such as dams, tunnels, and underground power plants; resource development including oil, gas, metals, and minerals; energy and environmental issues such as energy storage and radioactive waste disposal; and safety and disaster management issues such as earthquakes and slope failures.

The International Society for Rock Mechanics and Rock Engineering (ISRM) was established in 1962 to address these challenges internationally. It currently operates with over 8,500 members and 60 National Groups. To present the latest research findings and achievements and facilitate academic exchange, the ISRM holds regional symposia in six regions worldwide—Africa, Asia, Australasia (Australia, New Zealand, and surrounding islands), Europe, South America, and North America—and hosts an international symposium including a Council Meeting once a year.

This time, the Japan Society for Rock Mechanics (JSRM)—a general incorporated association comprising the Japan Society of Civil Engineers (JSCE); the Japanese Geotechnical Society (JGS); the Mining and Materials Processing Institute of Japan (MMIJ); and the Society of Materials Science, Japan (JSMS) as organizational members, along with 297 individual members and 36 supporting corporate members—has decided to organize the 14th Asian Rock Mechanics Symposium (ARMS14). Beyond traditional rock mechanics themes, this symposium will focus on the contribution of rock mechanics to global challenges in natural disaster management and mitigation, energy issues, and environmental problems. This symposium was selected at the ISRM Council Meeting as the 2026 ISRM International Symposium and will be held in November 2026 in Fukuoka City.

This ISRM International Symposium will be the first in 12 years to be held in Japan, since the 8th Asian Rock Mechanics Symposium (ARMS8) was held in Sapporo in 2014. ARMS14 aims to showcase Japan's achievements in rock mechanics and, by demonstrating international leadership, to discuss how to tackle the main theme "Rock Mechanics for the Next Generation —Innovation, Sustainability, and Resilience" and how to chart directions for new research and technological development.

ARMS14 is a large-scale international symposium that will bring together the ISRM President, Vice Presidents, and representatives from 60 National Groups. In addition to research and technical presentations, it will also host Board and Council meetings, various Commission meetings, workshops, and other events. This presents an excellent opportunity for those of you engaged in research and development of related technologies in rock mechanics, disaster management, environment, resources, energy, construction, surveying, testing, analysis, and other fields to showcase your technologies, achievements, products, and services, while also providing an ideal chance for business development. We cordially request that you consider participating in the technical exhibition, which will also serve as valuable support for ARMS14.




